### **SIX YEARS ON AND STILL GOING STRONG!**

Busabout is in its sixth year of the Sydney Metropolitan Bus Service Contract for Transport for NSW, with exceptional results for on-time running and customer feedback management. Through ongoing roadwork and continued development in the area, Busabout have been able to deliver additional services to meet the increasing demand, whilst updating and adding buses to our ever-growing fleet.

### **NEWER AND YOUNGER FLEET**

In 2019, Busabout received five new replacement buses and one growth bus, with another four growth buses expected to arrive in 2020. These replacement buses are all two-door, airconditioned and low floor – wheelchair accessible buses. The addition of these buses ensures that our customers have access to more services, and experience a more comfortable journey.

### **SERVICE ENHANCEMENTS**

With the rapid residential growth in the Macarthur region, Busabout have developed service enhancements to add additional services and cater for the higher demand. An additional 13 peak route 841 trips provided between Gledswood Hills and Leppington Station were introduced in April 2019, and changes in the route path to use the newly opened Hermitage Way link road to service Emerald Hills and The Crest.

There have also been ongoing additions and changes to dedicated school services to accommodate for the large number of new residents moving to the area, with plans to service the newly opened Gledswood Hills Public School and Oran Park High School in Term 1, 2020.
